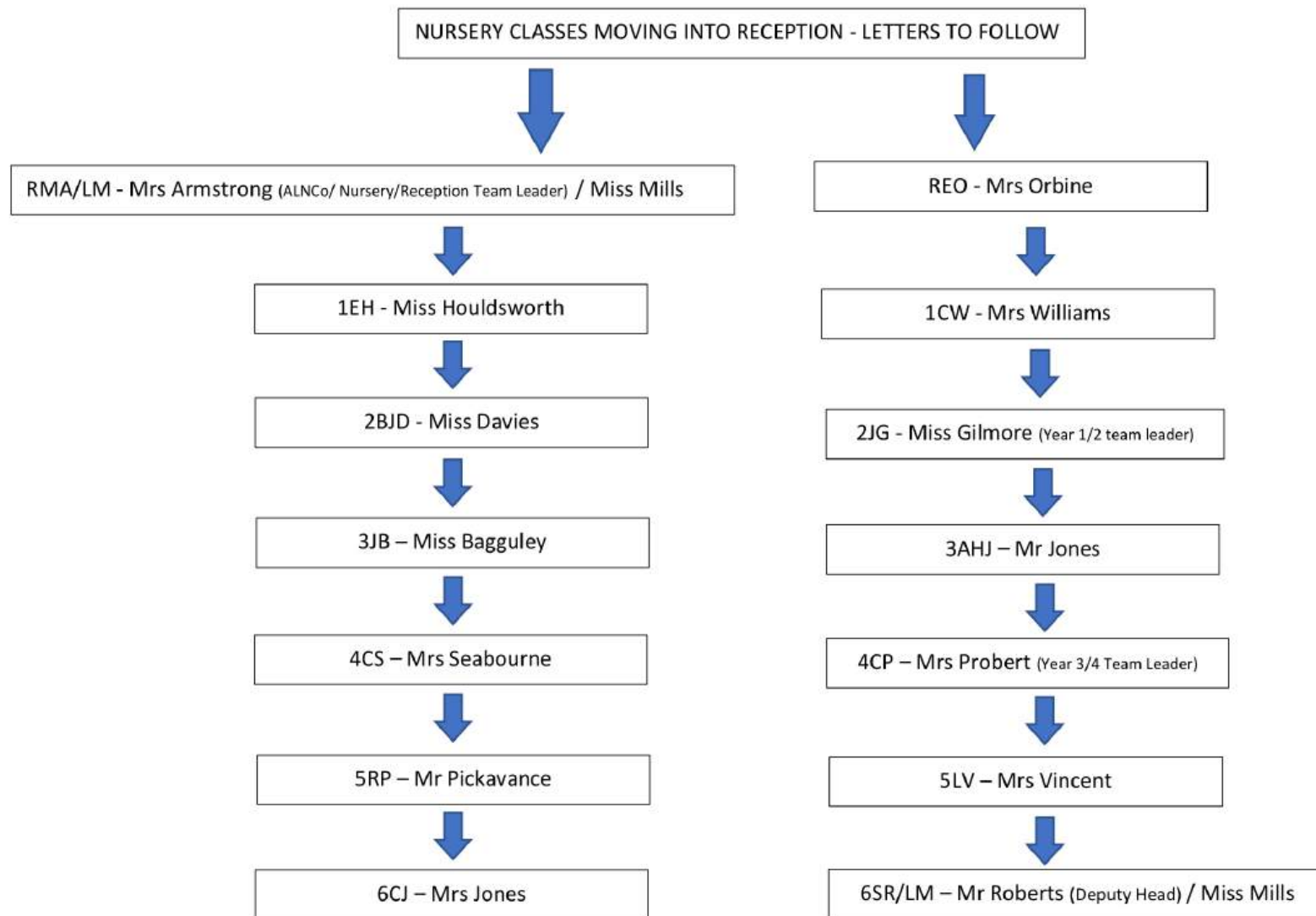
# CLASSES FOR 2026 - 27 Academic Year

It was a valuable and inspiring visit, giving the children a real insight into how their voices can be heard and how important it is to speak up about the future of our planet.





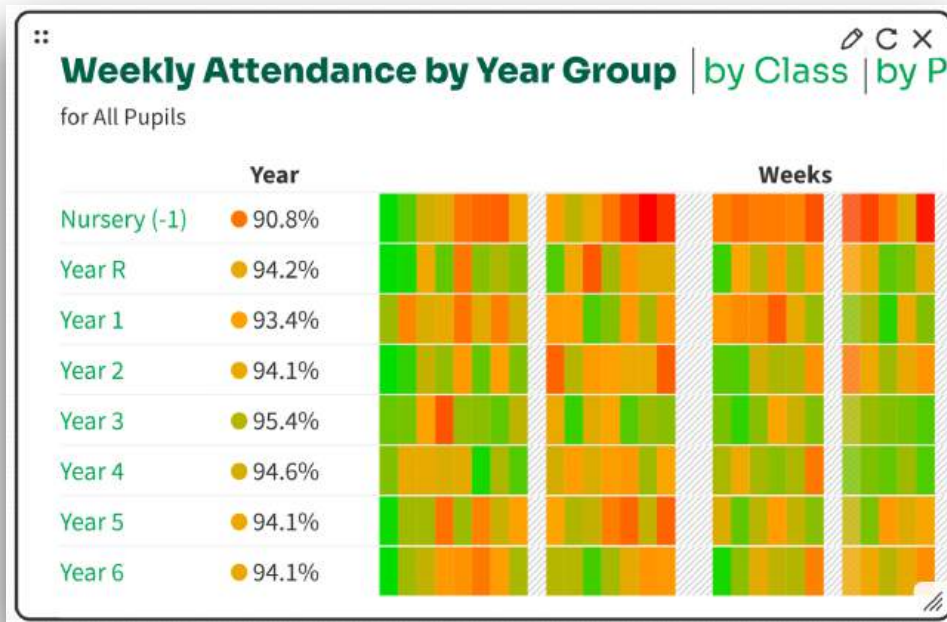

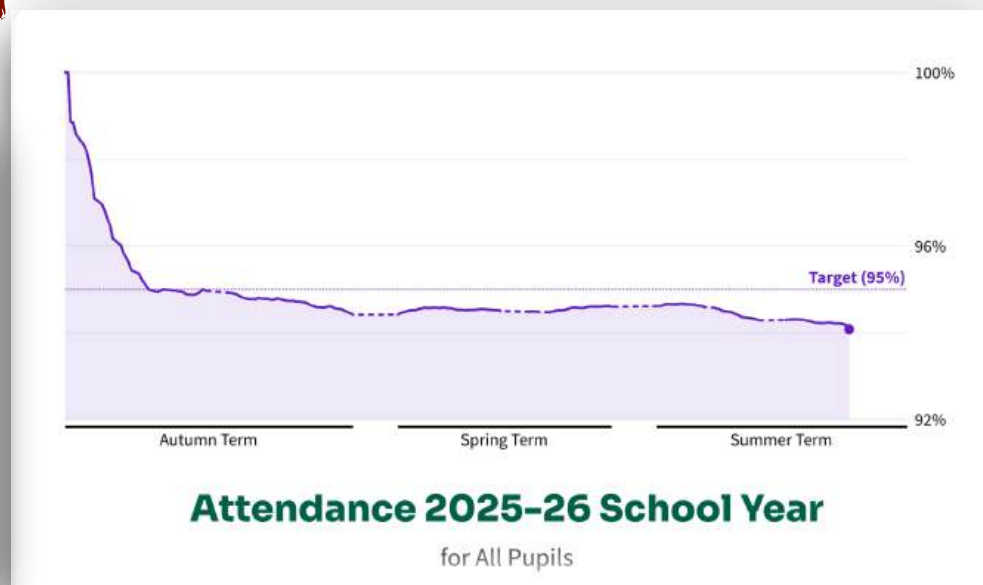
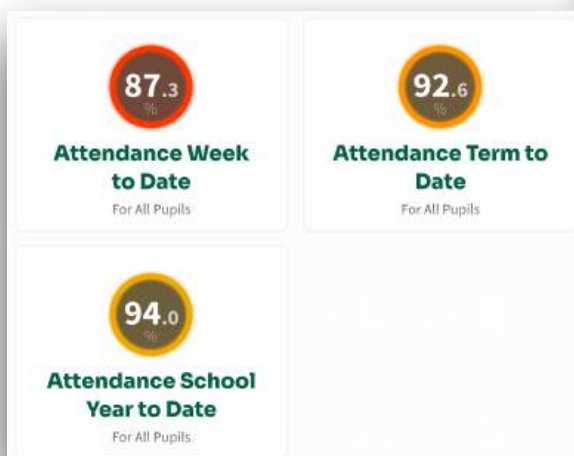
Absence request forms must be completed if children are taken out of school for anything other than illness. Please explain what you can on the form.

**We are at 94.0% for the year.**

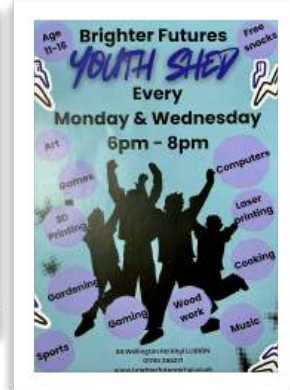
Our target is 95% or above. This weather hasn't helped.

The Hwb platform gives pupils in Wales access to a wide range of safe, free online tools and resources to support their learning.

Through Hwb, children can use programmes such as Microsoft 365 and Google Workspace to complete and share their work, as well as creative tools like Adobe Express and Minecraft Education to explore and present their ideas.

Pupils also have access to trusted research resources, interactive activities and teacher-set work, all in one secure place. These tools help children to work independently, collaborate with others and build important digital skills, while learning how to stay safe online.

Each child in Wales has login details for this platform.

They will have an email address such as;
